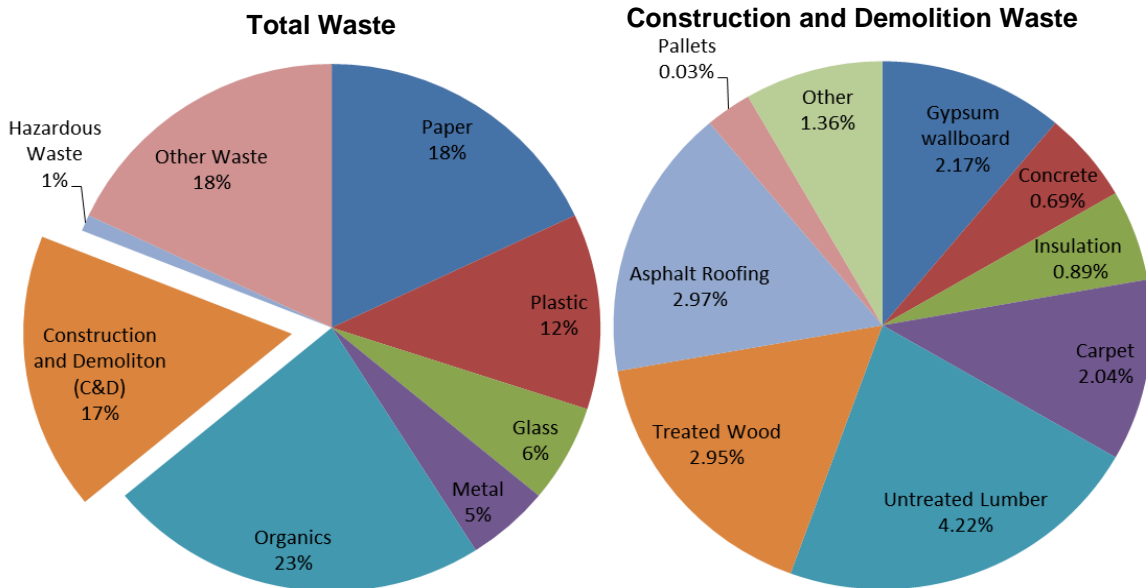


CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS

Recycling material generated by construction demolition and renovation conserves resources, saves energy, reduces greenhouse gas emissions and saves you money. Many construction debris that are taking up valuable landfill space could have been recycled. In Pierce County, construction and demolition debris accounts for 17% of the County's waste.
